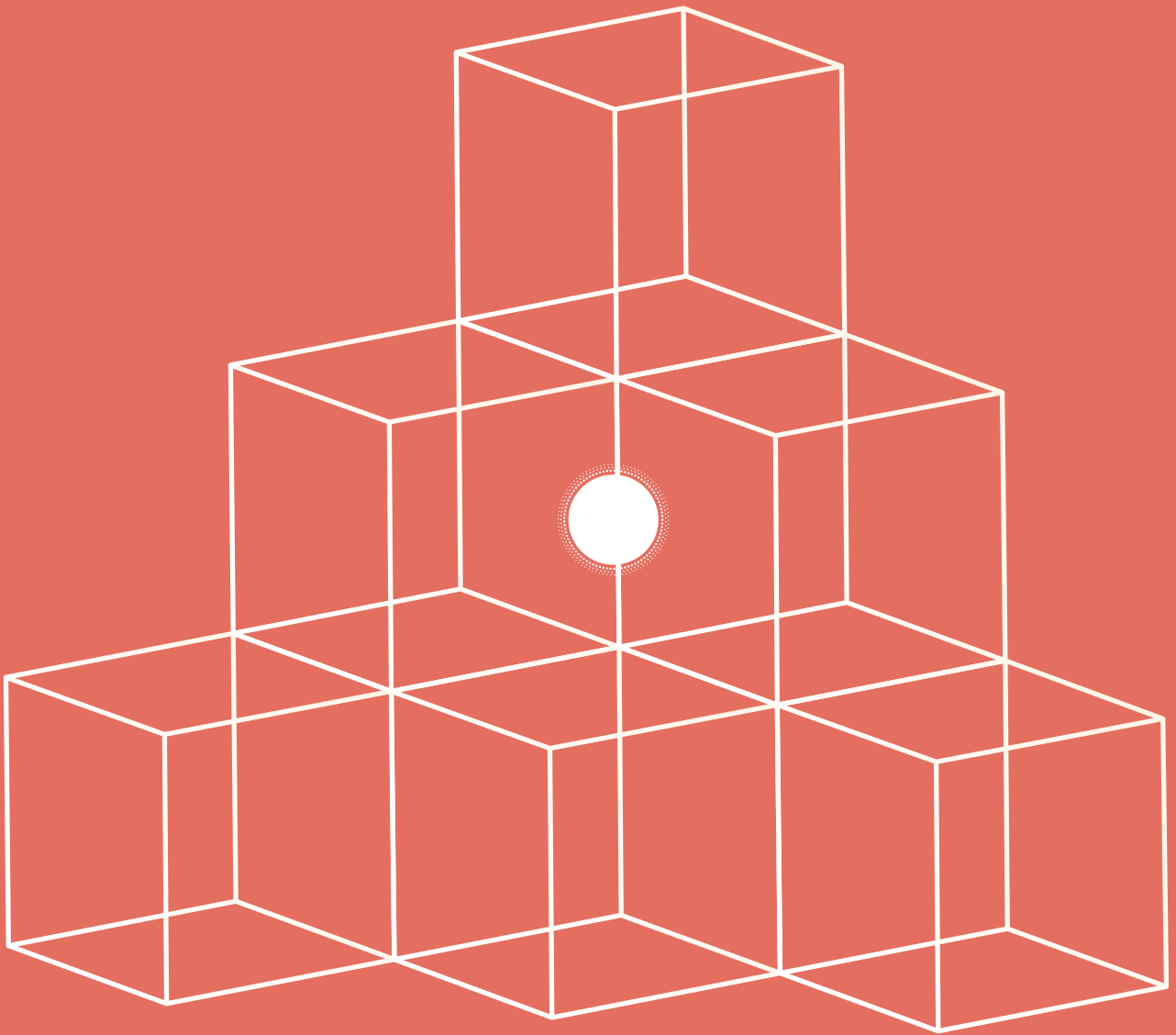

Five Journal Prompts for the Builder

- Where am I holding back because I am afraid of getting it wrong?
- What does progress look like to me? How will I know I am moving forward?
- If I trusted that action creates clarity, what would I do differently?
- What small habit or routine can I create to stay consistent with my reinvention?

Write freely and reflect on where you are hesitating. These prompts will help you move from waiting for the right moment to taking meaningful action.
